- For a small fee (\$10), classes provide in-depth learning.
- Most classes are offered as Hybrid, meaning they are In-person and also online through Zoom. Classes are NOT recorded.
- ▶ We utilize UWP professors and other area professionals as our speakers.
- When the group is attending a music or theatre performance we like to have a class prior to the performance to have the background knowledge before attending.
- Classes are on a wide variety of topics, such as: History, Music/Theatre, Science, etc.

<u>Met Live Opera classes</u>

- In a series of classes Greg Berg will lead us through the upcoming operas that you can see on your own, Live in HD, at the Renaissance Theater in Sturtevant or the Tinseltown Theater in Kenosha. You'll be sure to enjoy this class even if you don't attend all of the theater performances.
- Class is from 10 AM to 12 Noon, hybrid.

GREGORY BERG, our instructor: Professor Berg is on the music faculty at Carthage College in Kenosha, where he teaches voice and directs the opera productions.

- Fees are determined on a cost basis: bus, meal, admission, etc.

Self-Drive Trips:

- These are trips are to local area attractions and businesses within a 30 mile radius of UW-Parkside.
- ▶ Fees are less expensive because there is no bus cost.
- Refunds: if you cancel BEFORE the deadline you will receive a refund minus a fee. You can also transfer your ticket to someone else but only on an emergency basis.

Annual Membership

Membership is \$50 per year, starting the month that you join- rolling membership

- We also offer a parking permit. You need a permit to park anywhere on campus. (Unless you have a handicap permit)
 - The Parking Permit is valid from Sept 1 every year to the next year end of August. The ALL office sells the permits in the office. The price is controlled by the Police Department on campus.

There are outside parking kiosks ONLY in the Student Center and The RITA parking lots. The rates are \$1 per hour or \$6 for all day. The kiosks only take credit card payment - NO cash or coins. One-day pass for \$6 can be purchased at the information desk in the Student Center, the Police Station (east side of Tallent Hall), or in the ALL Office when open.
