SEMESTER HIGHLIGHTS

Congressional Hearing – Chancellor Ford's Testimony

Chancellor Debbie Ford called it an honor to testify before the U.S. House of Representatives Select Committee on the Economy on Monday. The field hearing, which was held at the University of Wisconsin-Parkside's Student Center, highlighted the efforts of area businesses and the university to create a climate that helps graduates move successfully into the workforce. It marked the first time a Congressional Hearing was held in Wisconsin.



UW-Parkside's Communication Department Receives UW System's Highest Honor

The Communication Department at the University of Wisconsin Parkside was awarded the UW System's Board of Regents Teaching Excellence Award. The prestigious award, the System's highest honor, was presented to the department at the Board of Regents meeting on April 8 in Stevens Point.

Parkside Day Participants Give and Give Back: A Record Breaking Year

On April 7, the University of Wisconsin-Parkside hosted its fourth annual Parkside Day, a day of giving and activities in support of the university, with presenting sponsor HARIBO of America. Based on preliminary results, more than 1,700 individuals across the nation participated in the day through donating, volunteering, and the Ranger Run run/walk event. Parkside Day generated \$155,086 in donations to scholarships, athletics, and programs of the university from 1,082 donors.

UW-Parkside Receives Funding from Freshwater Collaborative of Wisconsin to Train Next Generation of Water Scientists

The University of Wisconsin-Parkside received more than \$40,000 from the Freshwater Collaborative of Wisconsin (FCW) to enhance its water-related academic programs. FCW funding is part of a statewide initiative, backed by the Wisconsin State Legislature and Gov. Tony Evers, to tackle 10 grand water challenges and support curriculum development, undergraduate research opportunities, career development, and field-training experiences for students interested in studying water-related subjects at the 13 UW schools.

UW-Parkside Students Participate in Research in the Rotunda

University of Wisconsin-Parkside students joined nearly 150 undergraduates across the University of Wisconsin System to showcase their outstanding research at the 18th annual Research in the Rotunda on March 9 at the State Capitol in Madison. UW-Parkside students and their faculty mentors discussed their poster displays inside the state Capitol Rotunda. The event, which returned this year after a one-year hiatus, featured six selected undergraduate student research projects with presenters from each of the 13 UW campuses. Attendees also included chancellors, provosts, and vice chancellors.

UW-Parkside Chancellor Debbie Ford: Education = Equity

The data is clear, a college education is one of the best ways to address persistent inequality in our society and provide access to economic opportunity for low-income, first-generation students and students of color. As the most diverse four-year campus in the University of Wisconsin System, I'm proud that UW-Parkside is dedicated to creating a highly educated, diverse workforce in southeastern Wisconsin. Nearly 60% of our students are first-generation and our minority representation is 31.4%, reflecting the urban core of our region. Another point of pride is our designation as an Emerging Hispanic Serving Institution (HSI), the first public university in Wisconsin to earn this recognition. Hispanic students now comprise 17.9% of our student population.

UW-Parkside Selected as Education Partner for Amazon Career Choice Program

The University of Wisconsin-Parkside was selected as an education partner for Amazon's Career Choice program. This transformational partnership paves the way for full-time and part-time Amazon employees in southeastern Wisconsin to receive generous college tuition benefits designed to upskill employees and help them move into higher paying career opportunities. Locally, the Career Choice program will impact employees at Amazon's fulfillment centers in Kenosha.

Andrew Gavin Named NACDA Athletic Director of the Year

Parkside Director of Athletics Andrew Gavin was named a 2021-22 National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) Cushman & Wakefield AD of the Year, which was announced on Wednesday, March 15, 2022. Gavin, who joined Parkside in August of 2017, will be honored in conjunction with the 57th Annual NACDA & Affiliates Convention on June 28 in Las Vegas, Nev. He is one of the four winners from NCAA Division II, along with Joseph Clinton (Dominican College), Clyde Doughty (Bowie State) and Bren Stevens (U of Charleston).

UW-Parkside Hosts First Annual Smart Cities U

The University of Wisconsin-Parkside was excited to announce the first annual Smart Cities U, a virtual certificate program designed to assist and empower local leaders to better understand and manage the multidimensional nature of economic development.

The virtual sessions were held in March and April. This innovative new series was sponsored by the Center for Research in Innovation and Smart Cities, the College of Social Sciences and Professional Studies, and Professional and Continuing Education, and will be taught by faculty and industry-recognized experts.

UW-Parkside Celebrates Women's History Month

Wes Saber, Executive Vice President & Chief Financial Officer, HARIBO of America

Wes Saber has been an international leader in innovative management philosophy and business strategy for more than 25 years. His expertise in developing global enterprises has led him to his current role as Executive Vice President and Chief Financial Officer for HARIBO of America, the #1 gummi brand in the U.S. and a generous supporter of University of Wisconsin-Parkside.

Mr. Saber has been the CFO and a Board member of HARIBO, the world's leading manufacturer of gummi products and the original inventor of the gummi bear. The business has a 100-year history and employs nearly 7,000 Associates and operates 16 production sites in 10 countries. Mr. Saber spearheaded the addition of HARIBO's latest production site, soon bringing the total to 17 factories in 11 countries.

HARIBO's first-ever North American manufacturing facility. Located in Pleasant Prairie, Wis., it's set to begin production in 2023 and will be one of the largest confectionery plants in the U.S. and a historic milestone for the company. The nearly \$400 million project represents one of the largest direct investments by an international company in Wisconsin history, creating hundreds of career opportunities to Southeastern Wisconsin.

Under Mr. Saber's leadership, HARIBO of America, Inc. has seen double-digit growth since its relocation from Baltimore, Md. to Rosemont, Ill., in 2014. Mr. Saber's expertise in finance, business planning, supply chain management and human resources has well-positioned HARIBO to lead the gummi category through innovative products, efficient processes and attracting and retaining top talent. In 2021, Fortune recognized HARIBO of America as one of the top 25 small/medium companies in Manufacturing and Production, and the business was also recognized as a Great Place to Work.

Prior to joining HARIBO, Mr. Saber held leadership roles in 25 countries around the world, including Turkey, Egypt, Africa, United Arab Emirates, and the U.S. His most recent role was with Mars, Inc. where he worked with the chocolate segment to develop the business in Europe, Middle East, and the U.S. He has also held leadership roles in finance and marketing with Pizza Hut and KPMG.

A lifelong learner, Mr. Saber earned his M.B.A. from Northern Illinois University and has continued his education at Harvard Business School and the Center for Creative Leadership. He is an active Board Member of the Metropolitan Milwaukee Association of Commerce, the German American Chamber of Commerce Midwest, Vice Chair and Executive Committee member of the Kenosha Area Business Alliance Board, and an Executive Partner of the Milwaukee 7

Mr. Saber is also active in community giving, both personally and on behalf of HARIBO, leading partnerships with the Boys and Girls Club of Kenosha, Union League Boys and Girls Club of Chicago and the German International School of Chicago to support and expand educational programming, renovate classrooms and revitalize outdoor spaces.

Helton is tremendously hard working, always prepared, and attentive. Most importantly, his attitude toward education is ideal, as he constantly wants to learn more.



OUTSTANDING GRADUATE AWARDS

Sierra Malvitz Political Science & History

Sierra Malvitz has achieved an impressive GPA while enrolled in 15 credits per semester and working an average of 25-30 hours a week in an off-campus job. Malvitz is majoring in



both political science and history. She is a former member of the Parkside Environmental Club and was a student member representing the Politics, Philosophy, and Law Department on the Segregated University Fee Advisory Committee (SUFAC).

Malvitz holds the distinct honor of having her work published in a peer-reviewed journal article as an undergraduate student. In 2020-2021, she was hired as a research assistant on a project funded through the Tommy G. Thompson Center on Public Leadership. In this role, Malvitz was tasked with a content analysis of all 179 county and municipal law enforcement agency websites in the state of Wisconsin in order to assess the availability of information on these websites. This original dataset she helped create was then compared to whether the quantity and quality of information available on law enforcement websites are similar to those of local governments and school districts. The result of the study was a publication in the journal, *Policing:* An International Journal, which is well regarded in the field of criminal justice. Malvitz has a keen interest in studying gendered dynamics of society and has explored if the gendered composition of law enforcement agency websites impacted information availability.

Alisson Anguiano Salas English & Political Science

Alisson Anguiano Salas is a first-generation college student double majoring in English and Political Science with a concentration in Law, and a minor in Spanish.

She has served as Student



Government President and Co-Chair of the Student Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion Committee (SEDI), which she also assisted in developing. Anguiano Salas has served in various capacities with Latinos Unidos, including President, Scholarship Chair, and Secretary. She developed the Racine Equity and Environmental Justice group and created a survey shared throughout the county in English and Spanish, utilizing her fluency in both languages. Anguiano Salas was selected as recipient of the Andrew Goodman Ambassadorship, where she managed events for UW-Parkside to encourage civic engagement.

She earned the Newman Civic Fellowship, which supports students who are committed to their communities and continues her hands-on work in civic engagement as a member of the League of United Latin American Citizens (LULAC), and as a fellow for Leaders Igniting Transformation (LIT). Her fluency in English and Spanish have made her an invaluable tutor at the Parkside Academic Resource Center (PARC). She was selected for the National Collegiate Hispanic Honor Society, Sigma Delta Pi and is also a member of the International English Honor Society, Sigma Tau Delta.

OUTSTANDING GRADUATE AWARDS

Madelynn Sinclair Biological Sciences

Madelynn Sinclair's accomplishments exemplify her work ethic, high achievement, and success. In her "Animal Behavior" class, she took on a study of social behavior in cattle. Not



knowing any local farmers, she took initiative and sought out a suitable farm, convincing the farmer to allow her to do her research.

In "Vertebrate Zoology," she took part in a semesterlong study of the vertebrates inhabiting a wetland on campus. She spent hours recording the animals, their behavior, and their habitat. She was asked to become a Supplemental Instructor for the introductory course, Organismal Biology, and served in that role for three semesters.

At the Field Museum of Natural History in Chicago, Sinclair conducted a study of the heritability of morphological variation in a sea snake, Lapemis curtus. She was later appointed a Scientific Affiliate of the Museum.

Sinclair received a National Science Foundation
Research Experience for Undergraduates fellowship
at the American Museum of Natural History in
New York to work on the functional morphology
of bat vertebrae. Sinclair is also a gifted artist. She
illustrates the appearance and morphological
traits of her sea snakes, and makes the figures for
her presentations. After graduating, she plans to
complete her sea snake project at the Field Museum
and apply to graduate school.

Thomas Stirrat Biological Sciences

Thomas Stirrat has continually excelled in his pursuit of a college education. He came to UW-Parkside in the Spring of 2019 after completing an undergraduate degree in psychology from Saint



Louis University. At UW-Parkside, he maintained an impressive GPA while completing his second undergraduate degree.

In addition to his strong academic performance, Stirrat is committed to academic endeavors outside of the classroom. During his seven semesters at UW-Parkside, Stirrat has been engaged in nine different research experiences, with nine different professors, spanning three different departments at UW-Parkside, and three different universities. He served as a Supplemental Instructor on campus, as the President of Assist STEM and on the Dean's Student Council.

Stirrat founded and served as Editor-in-Chief of the Parkside Journal of Science, served as President of the Molecular Biology Club, and has been a Certified Nursing Assistant. He shadowed over half a dozen physicians in a variety of areas, served as a Hospice volunteer for three years, and volunteered as a Post-Anesthesia Care person for three years. Stirrat also volunteered at Bernie's Book Bank, the Northern Illinois Food Bank, Meals on Wheels, Hot Meals 2 Go, Food Pantry, and Christmas drive.

OUTSTANDING GRADUATES

Bo Brasseur Master of Science in Sport Management

Bo Brasseur is the first UW-Parkside Master of Science in Sport Management student to complete a thesis. Students in the program choose between gaining experience in the field



and taking a current issues course or completing a thesis. The thesis path requires students to work on a research project of their own creation. Her thesis topic examines what coaches know relative to the mental health aspect of athlete recovery.

In her graduate assistantship, Brasseur is required to teach the relaxation activity course. She was also the graduate assistant coach for the Track and Field and Cross Country programs, including coaching all jumps and throws and competing at an elite level herself.

Brasseur has been extremely impactful to UW-Parkside Athletics in many ways, including assisting with travel arrangements, educating athletes on nutritional needs and concepts, coaching almost all field event athletes, and helping plan and implement volunteer opportunities for the team. She is also competing internationally as a Long Jumper and was the Belgium 2020 and 2021 National Women's Long Jump champion.

She also assisted with the planning and implementation of an athlete fueling station, combining her undergraduate degree in dietetics and the knowledge she has gained in sport management to assist all student-athletes at UW-Parkside.

Timothy Zimmermann Master of Business Administration

Timothy Zimmermann maintained a stellar overall GPA to earn his Master of Business Administration (MBA). He also graduated with his undergraduate



degree from UW-Parkside in May 2018, with a double major in business management and economics. He is quick to participate in class and help others and his work is consistently well done, thorough and accurate. He also applies his academic aptitude to his full-time career in banking.

Zimmermann stands out as a student who works well without supervision and is highly self-motivated; two very important characteristics to hold as an MBA student. As an economics major, Zimmermann clearly demonstrated his careful and methodical thinking and his analytical prowess.

During his MBA coursework, Zimmerman worked full time for Educators Credit Union (ECU), dating back to before he graduated with his undergraduate degree. His goal is to provide financial understanding to the community in efforts to make others more financially sound. Zimmerman co-leads ECU's branches donations efforts for United Way of Kenosha and Racine counties. Zimmermann also has experience teaching high school students at Indian Trail Academy about finances through their "Reality Check Days." His goal is to bring his knowledge from his MBA to local high schools to help students with financial literacy.

Kelly Burke Accounting, Management Information Systems, Marketing & Business Management

Kelly Burke is graduating with four majors: Accounting, Management Information Systems, Marketing and Business Management with a finance concentration. She is also completing certificates in project management and sales. Burke has achieved a near-perfect GPA and has been on the Dean's and Provost's lists every semester. She has been inducted into Beta Gamma Sigma, a business honor society. Burke is married with a family of eight children and works a full-time job as a quality-control supervisor.



Burke has served as the Vice-President of the Accounting Club, as an ambassador for Becker Accounting, and is a member of the Wisconsin chapter of Women in Technology – an organization that promotes women's participation in technology/STEM fields and careers. Burke met with the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB) visit team as a student representative when the business department went through the re-accreditation process. Burke also participated in "Rebuilding Kenosha," and worked as an intern for a local company, where she utilized her information systems knowledge and skills to build databases. She is planning to start a non-profit organization and has been admitted to UW-Parkside's MBA program, which she will start in fall 2022.

Dr. Suresh Chalasani, a professor in the Department of Business says, "It is not often that we see a non-traditional student with work and life responsibilities pursuing four different majors, two different certificates, and achieving a near-perfect GPA. It is not often that we see an exceptionally well-rounded student represent UW-Parkside on our campus and the surrounding community admirably. In an age where we are seeking to increase women's participation in quantitative and technical fields, Kelly's luminary achievements in multiple majors serve as a guiding light to future students."



COMMENCEMENT TRADITIONS

ACADEMIC ATTIRE

Traditional academic attire of caps, gowns, and hoods dates to the 12th century, when faculty were often members of the clergy who wore garb similar to those of church orders. Over the centuries, this formal academic attire has come to symbolize the academic achievement of the wearer.

The gown and hood symbolize the degree the wearer holds or is about to receive. The bachelor's degree gown has a closed front and long, pointed sleeves. The master's degree gown has a closed sleeve with a slit near the upper arm and the pointed part of the sleeve dangling below the arm. The doctor's gown is faced with velvet and has three chevrons on each bell shaped sleeve. The velvet may be black or its color could indicate the field in which the degree was taken; the most common color is dark blue signifying the Ph.D. Notable exception to the traditional black doctor's robes are those worn by graduates of Yale (blue) and Harvard (crimson). We also have faculty with degrees from international universities who wear different styles of robes or hoods.

Hoods are rarely worn for bachelor's degrees. The master's hood is shorter than the doctor's and lacks its colored panels. Hoods are lined with the colors of the institution granting the degree and are edged with velvet in the color symbolic of the wearer's academic field: business, tan; science, gold; dark blue for the Ph.D. designates learning and scholarship and not a degree in philosophy.

The mortarboard cap came into use after the hood was no longer worn on the head. The tassel, worn over the left temple, is usually black although a colored tassel can be worn to designate an academic discipline. The doctor's cap may be a tam or soft cap of various designs, and the tassel may be gold.

COMMENCEMENT SYMBOLS

The University Medallion is worn by the chancellor. The medallion incorporates the university mark and was made by Judith Olsen, '75, Art. The flags displayed on the platform carry the colors of the academic disciplines. The mace, of brass and raw purple heartwood, is a symbol of authority carried by the grand marshal. The mace was designed by Rollin G. Jansky, emeritus associate professor of art.
